The journal is also interested in scholarship that identifies continuities and discontinuities with medieval religious and devotional traditions. All articles in *Reformation* undergo rigorous peer review, based on anonymized refereeing by at least two referees. We're always interested in receiving proposals for such issues. The journal has over the years published scholarship by influential scholars in the field. The declared aims of EMoDiR are the promotion of national and international research projects; organising seminars, meetings, conferences and workshops; publication of its own activities; supporting interdisciplinary and international collaboration; disseminating research carried out by the group; establishing research networks and academic exchanges.

We send a monthly newsletter with information on research activities, conference participation, workshops, recent publications on the subject of early modern religious dissents and radicalism.
