II. News from EMoDiR

CFP for EMoDiR Workshop and General Assembly, November 30 - December 2, 2023, Goethe University in Frankfurt am Main, Germany. Deadline on September 4, 2023

The Early Modern period can be fairly described as a time characterised by religious conflict, dissent, aggressions, persecutions and different forms of harassment. Many

religious communities suffered these, Catholics in Protestant countries, Protestants in Catholic regions, and dissenters and non-Christian minorities throughout Christian Europe. If on the one side, persecutors used violence to extirpate error or heresy, punish and marginalise or redeem and convert the persecuted, the latter often transformed the suffering they endured to construct their own identity and to tighten community bonds. This is most evident, for instance, in the production of martyrologies, chronicles, treatises and specific artefacts. The historiographical literature on the dynamics of religious persecution is certainly large, but two research questions seem to have received less scholarly attention: to what extent mediations, negotiations, and accommodations between the persecutors and the persecuted played a crucial role in creating religious identities alongside coercion and persecution; and how can we take into account discussions that permeate both today's scholarly and public debate around the political use of genealogy, the fluidity of identities and the problematic standpoint of "affectedness". Can we go beyond the stereotypical narrative of the winning persecutors against the defeated persecuted without ignoring or even glossing over power relations? If so, what stories can reconstruct the complex nature of persecutor-persecuted relations? How can intersecting power relations be accounted for?

This call for papers aims to reconsider the study of early modern religious otherness, including non-Christian traditions, by addressing the topic of genealogy and identity elaborated through conflict and resilience in the early modern period. Its goal is to reflect on the empowerment of minorities and its political implications in order to rethink stereotypes of victims and victimisation. Questions that papers can address include, but are not limited to:

- How did religious minorities remember the conflict and persecutions they endured? To what extent can we presume practices of mediation?
- How did religious authorities circumscribe the religious "other"? How powerful was the religious "other" in the eyes of religious authorities? Did they learn from examples?
- To what extent did religious minorities/religious dissenters practise obedience and disobedience against religious and state authorities?
- Was there a strict relation between the theories and practices of ecclesiastical taxonomies, or was there space for negotiations?
- Was there a gendered and social bias when forcing discipline upon others? Can we observe the intersection of different social categories besides religious difference?

Each presentation should be 20 minutes long. Scholars who wish to submit their

proposal can send the titles and abstracts (max 250 words) of their presentations by September 4th to X.vonTippelskirch@em.uni-frankfurt.de and francesco.quatrini@gmail.com. Subject to funding approval, reimbursement for some travel expenses will be available for speakers. The publication of selected papers is planned. EMOdiR General Assembly will take place in the framework of the Workshop. Remote participation will be possible.
